

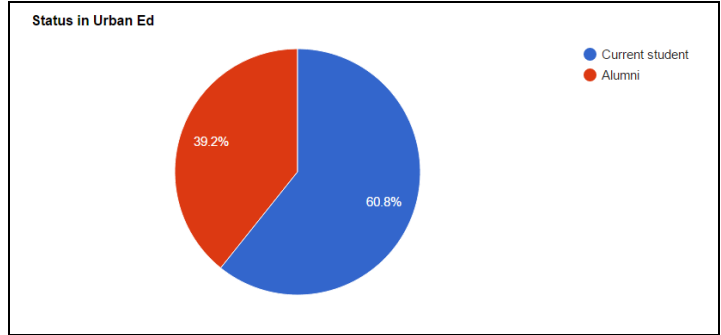
Urban Education Faculty Search Student/Alumni Survey

Results

80 people participated in the poll representing 35% of urban education students/alumni.

41% of total current students and 28 % of total alumni are represented in the survey

Of the sample, 60.8% were alumni and 39.2% were students.



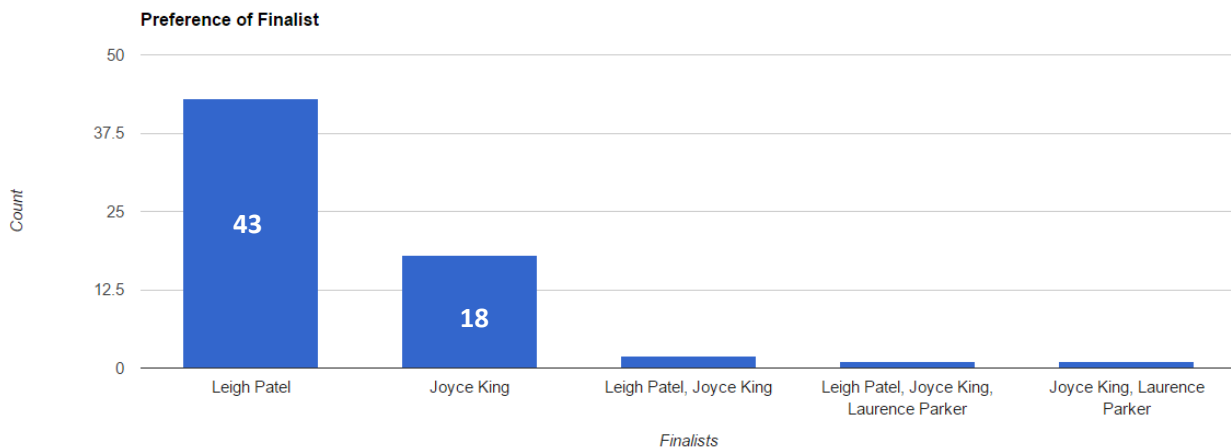
90% said they were **concerned** that no core faculty member has been hired to succeed Jean Anyon.¹

90% feel it is **urgent or extremely urgent** to fill the open faculty position

Given that the search for a new faculty member has been closed, **87%** of students and alumni are **concerned or extremely concerned** about the immediate and long-term strength of the Urban Education program.

96% find it to be **important or extremely important** that the Urban Education program faculty be racially diverse (with 89% feeling it is extremely important.)

66% are **not satisfied or somewhat not satisfied** with the current level of diversity overall in the program faculty (with 22% neutral and 12% satisfied or very satisfied).
